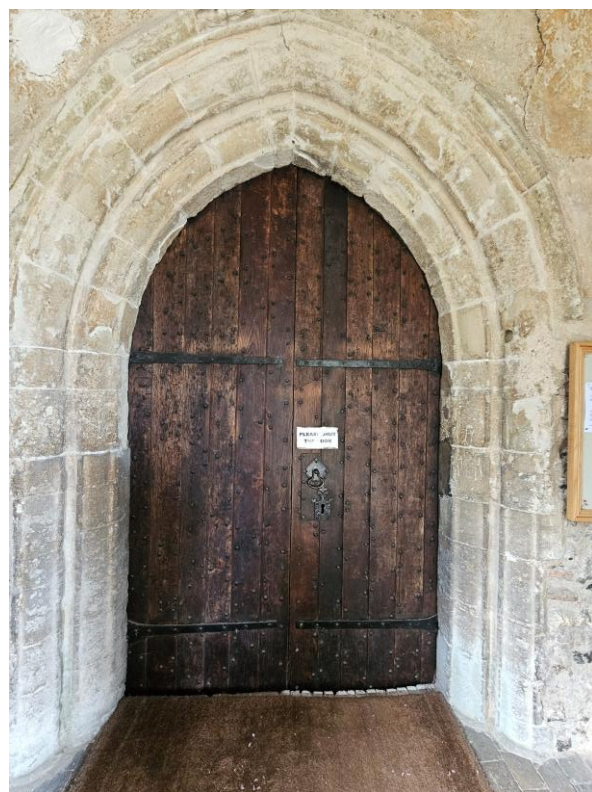


I am going to

The seats in church are called pews. They are in rows facing the front, except for the choir



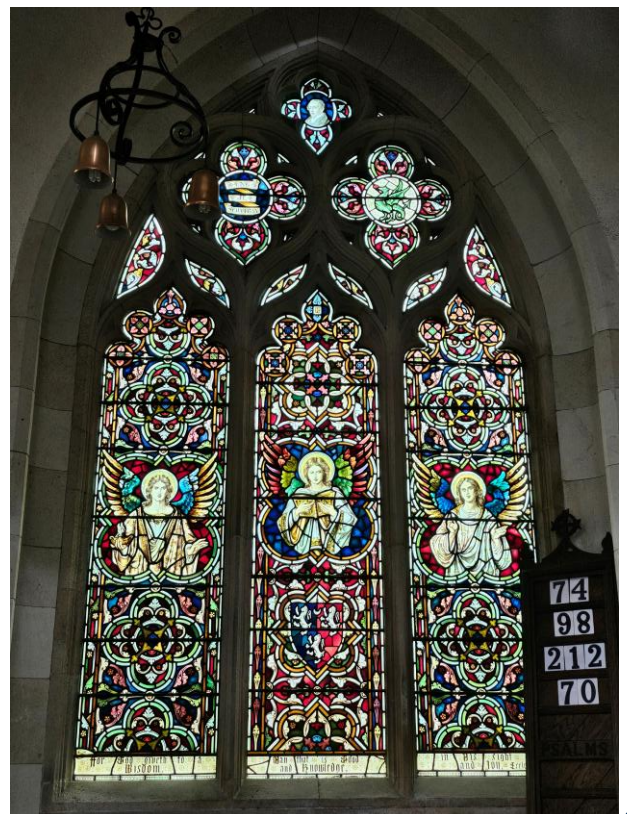
There may be someone playing the organ

The windows are very different in the church; they are pictures made of coloured glass. The windows are portraits of important people and sometimes tell stories.



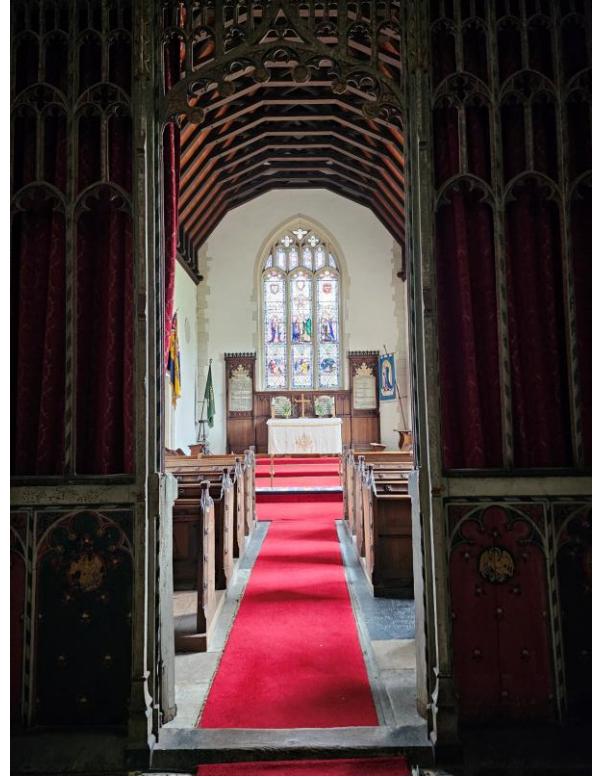
There are special paintings on the wall, they are 900 years old! I can see pictures of the Easter Story.
